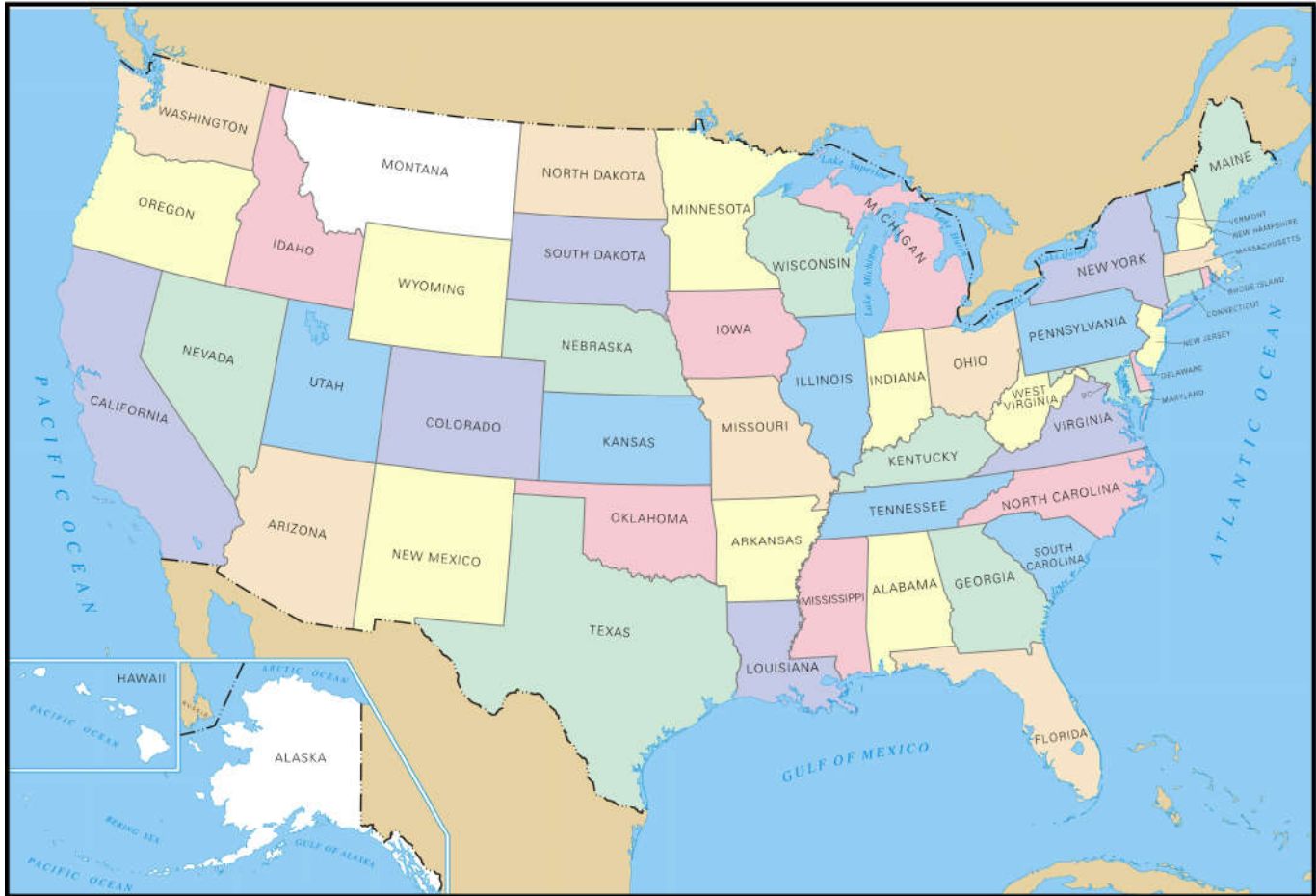


Submarine Industrial Base Suppliers
