

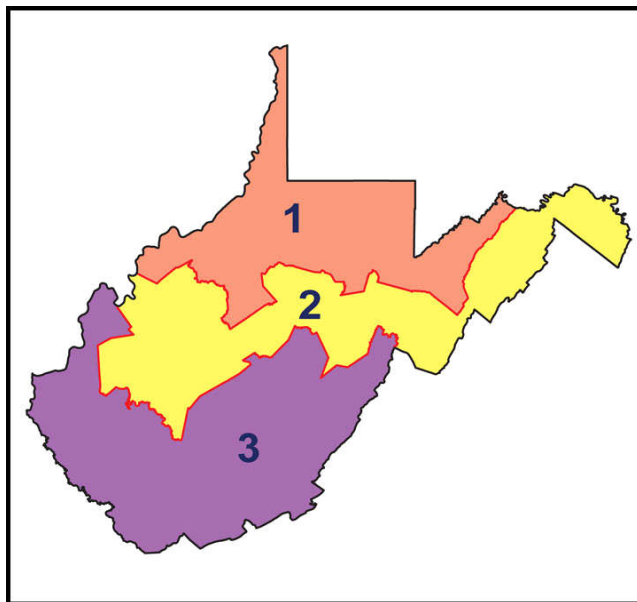

The WEST VIRGINIA submarine industrial base has received approximately \$28,659,162.72 in purchase order awards which provided highly skilled, high-wage manufacturing jobs producing specialized components and materials. These products include:

- High Strength Fasteners
- Shipboard Fire Control Equipment
- Corrosion Resistant Alloys
- Industrial Chemicals



Funding listed is the total amount spent or contracted to submarine suppliers over the past five years for major submarine programs. While the maps offer a good representation of the economic impact submarine programs have on communities, it is estimated that thousands of additional lower tier suppliers exist across the U.S. that are not represented.

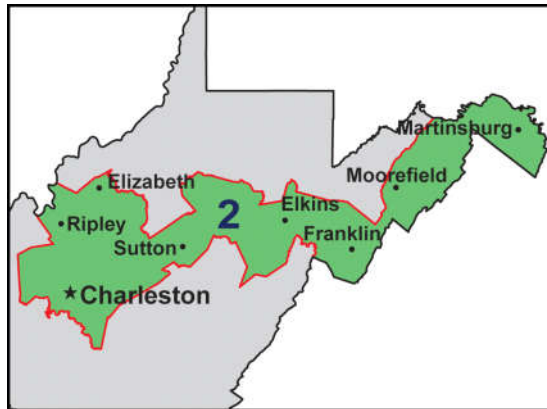

West Virginia - 3 Districts

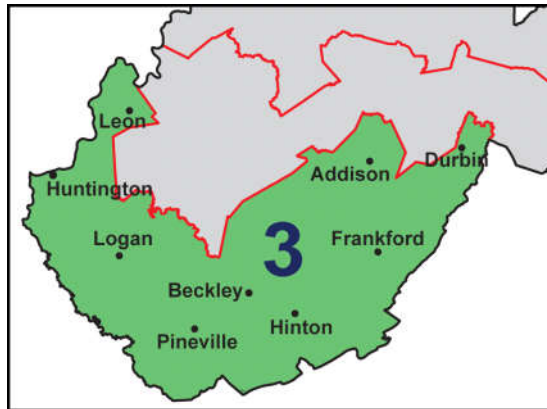
