

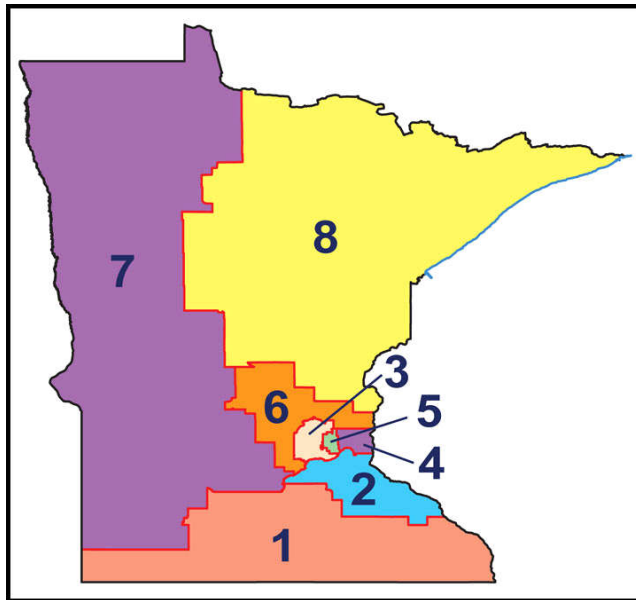

The MINNESOTA submarine industrial base has received approximately \$66,694,676.05 in purchase order awards which provided highly skilled, high-wage manufacturing jobs producing specialized components and materials. These products include:

Funding listed is the total amount spent or contracted to submarine suppliers over the past five years for major submarine programs.
