

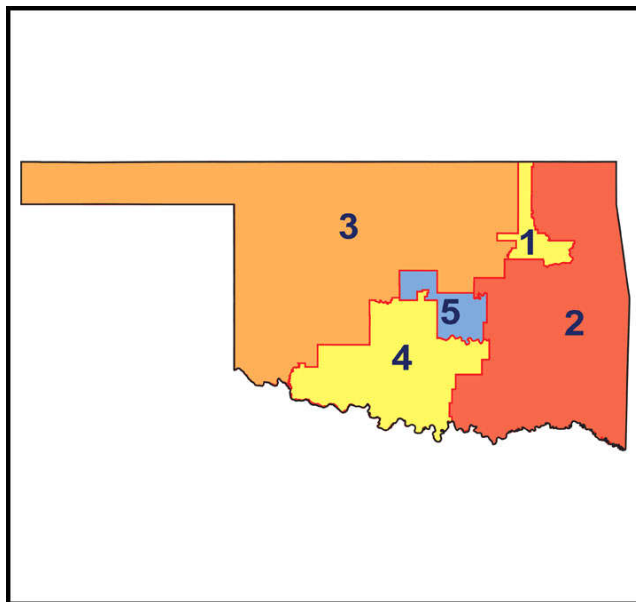

The OKLAHOMA submarine industrial base has received approximately \$73,717,060.61 in purchase order awards which provided highly skilled, high-wage manufacturing jobs producing specialized components and materials. These products include:

- Air Compressors
- Electrical Connectors
- Fiber Optics



Funding listed is the total amount spent or contracted to submarine suppliers over the past five years for major submarine programs. While the maps offer a good representation of the economic impact submarine programs have on communities, it is estimated that thousands of additional lower tier suppliers exist across the U.S. that are not represented.

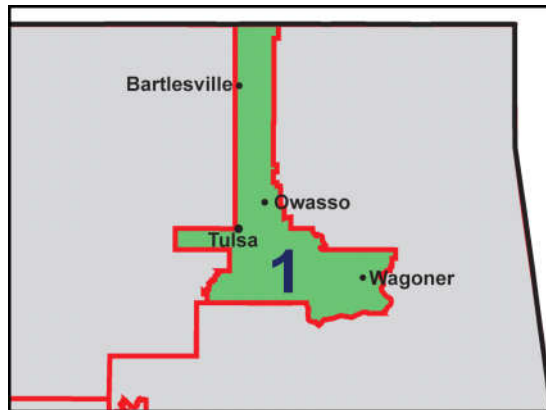

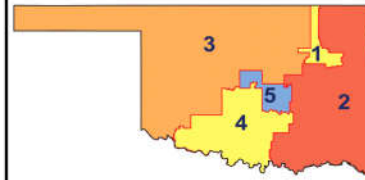
