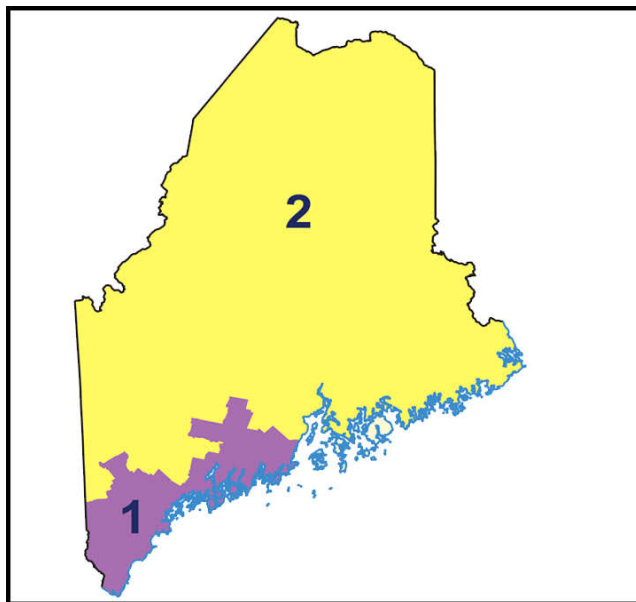

Funding listed is the total amount spent or contracted to submarine suppliers over the past five years for major submarine programs. 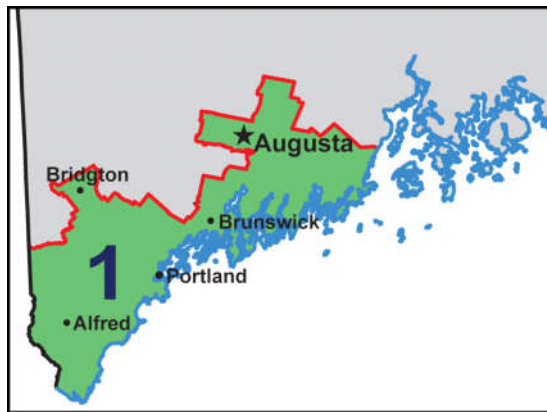

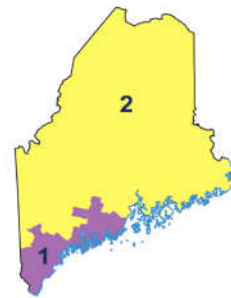

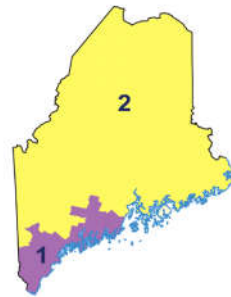
