

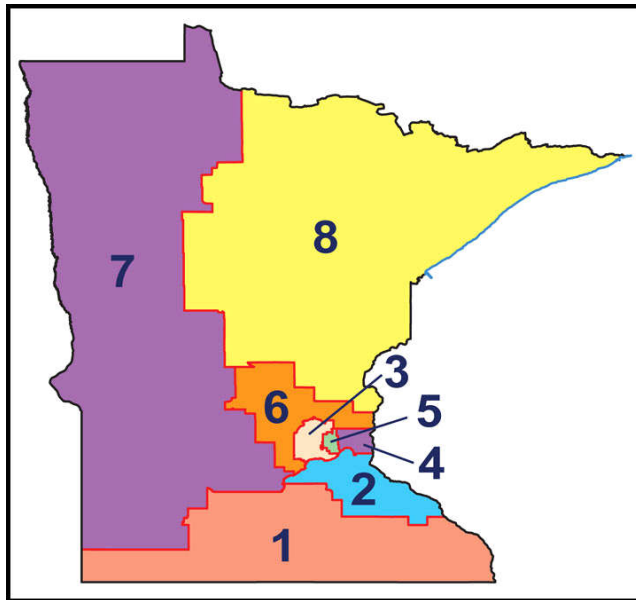

Minnesota - 8 Districts



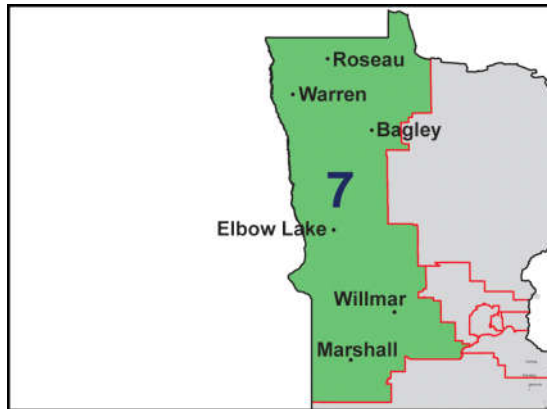

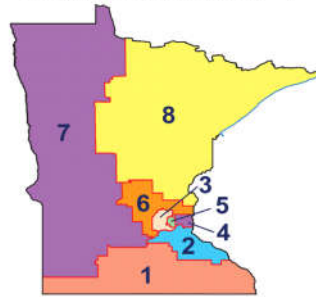
