

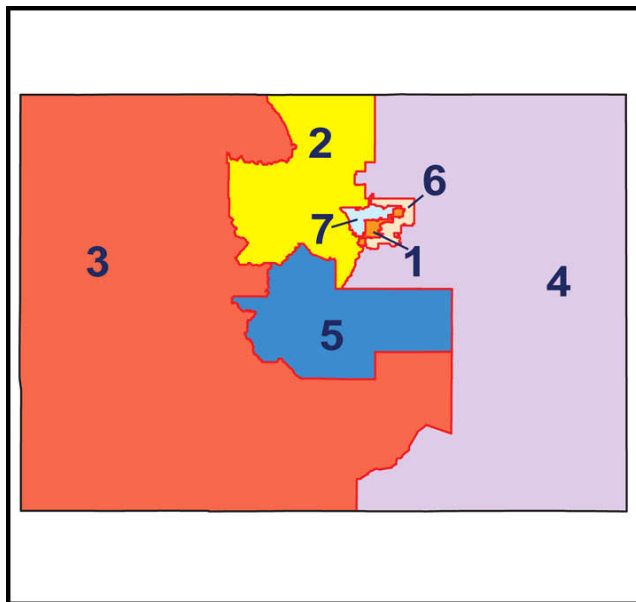

## 15 Submarine Industrial Base Suppliers

The COLORADO submarine industrial base has received approximately \$182,161,333.16 in purchase order awards which provided highly skilled, high-wage manufacturing jobs producing specialized components and materials. These products include:

- Bearing Assembly
- Metalworking
- Calibration Services
- Computers
- Water and Wastewater Treatment Products
- Machined Valve Parts



Funding listed is the total amount spent or contracted to submarine suppliers over the past five years for major submarine programs. While the maps offer a good representation of the economic impact submarine programs have on communities, it is estimated that thousands of additional lower tier suppliers exist across the U.S. that are not represented.
